

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

Superhero play on trim trail.
Discuss what superheroes need to keep them strong - exercise, healthy food.
Superfood tasting - what foods should a superhero eat?
Have an awareness of safety - when someone is in danger
Move around, over, under etc with increasing control
Design a superhero exercise regime

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

Use camera to take photos of each other as superheroes.
Activ-inspire - design a superhero logo
Superhero potion
Super-senses
Investigate ice, water, fire, magnets etc
Consider how characters change over time.
Think about real-life superheroes- how do they help us? What problems do they face? (police, fire, doctors, army)
Use the Ipad/computer with awareness of e-safety

PERSONAL, SOCIAL & EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Discuss how we are all unique - have special superhero powers (things we are good at)
People who are superheroes to us e.g family
Keeping yourself safe (protective behaviours)
Teamwork - how do superheroes work together as a team?
Making good choices.
First aid station - showing concern for others
