

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

Funky fingers
Cooking -
Move in different ways - balancing, travelling over, under equipment.
Healthy eating/exercise.
Pencil grip and control.
Discuss washing hands - germs etc
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UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

Plant in large planters outside.
Plant a sunflower seed and keep a diary of it growing.
Find out about food from different countries.
Explore the life cycle of plants - how they change as they grow.
Discuss where food comes from - animals/plants etc

PERSONAL, SOCIAL & EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Talk about own abilities, speak positively about self, reflect on the goals they had set.
Negotiate and solve problems on their own
Discuss boundaries in the setting - right from wrong.
Talk about likes and dislikes - food tasting.

LITERACY

Ascribe meanings to marks.
Form recognisable letters, with some sounds in sequence.
Begin to form simple words and sentences.
Retell a story in sequence.
Handle books carefully and enjoy looking at a range of books.
Write signs/labels for garden centre.
Write a list of ingredients.
Write a simple recipe.
