HOME-SCHOOL PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT

The School will:-

- Encourage children to do their best at all times

- Contact you as soon as possible if we have worries about your child's work or behaviour
- Welcome you into the life of the school and keep you informed on the work that is planned for your child
- Keep you fully informed about your child's progress
- Contact you if we are concerned about your child's attendance and punctuality

The Child will:-

- I will work hard and always try to do my best
- I will take good care of the books and equipment in my school
- I will try to be friendly and helpful to others in school
- I will follow the class and playground rules
- I will not hurt others
- I will try to make the right choices with my behaviour
- I will speak to an adult if I have a problem
- I will walk in school and not run (inside the school building)

The Family will:-

- Make sure that my child arrives in school on time and is collected on time
- Ensure that my child is well rested and nourished before coming to school, appropriately dressed
- Make sure my child attends school regularly and inform the school as soon as possible of the reason for any absence
- Support the school in maintaining good behaviour and discipline by encouraging responsibility in my child for his/her actions
- Support my child with his/her home activities such as reading regularly
- Attend parents evenings and discussions about my child's progress at school
- Talk to the school if my child is worried about attending school or if something happens to affect my child's learning
- Read and reply to any school correspondence
- Ensure that the school always knows how to make contact in an emergency
- Take appropriate steps when using social networking media and other web-based IT to ensure the safety of my child at all times **including not posting any photographs or videos taken in school or on school grounds on any internet site.**
